**Previous Ground Description:**  
**Description:** The Adirondack Experience (ADKX) will be renovating what it refer to as its Main Building. The structure is not listed on state or national registers. It was built in 1955 - 1957 and an addition was added in 1966. The building was designed by Adams & Woodbridge for exhibition purposes. The interior is to be renovated so that museum-quality environmental conditions can be maintained. Walls and ceilings will be demolished so that insulation can be installed. A new HVAC system, electrical, and data lines will be installed The only exterior work will involve the building's only two windows. One was covered over approximately 25 years ago. It will be replaced with a universally accessible entrance The other, which was covered over more recently, will be reopened. The near total absence of windows is a result of the building's having been designed to exclude natural light. There will be no ground disturbance. No HVAC equipment will be mounted on the building's exterior.
